June 7th, 2020 - if you drown in cold fresh water the temperature change as the water enters your bloodstream may even cool your heart enough to cause cardiac arrest from hypothermia on the other hand in salt water the cold water does not enter your bloodstream so the effects of temperature are mainly limited to heat loss across your skin

June 7th, 2020 - mottling of skin before death is mon and usually occurs during the final week of life although in some cases it can occur earlier mottling is caused by the heart no longer being able to pump blood effectively because of this blood pressure drops causing extremities to feel cool to the touch the skin then starts to be discolored

December 7th, 2019 - the epidermis is the upper part of the skin that is continuously renewed the keratinocytes are the major cell type in the epidermis and undergo a specialized form of programmed cell death called cornification which is different from classical apoptosis
